Criteria:

To be eligible, a student must:

- a. Be a graduate of the Mott/Regent High School
- b. Pursue a degree in education
- c. Be a full or part-time student in good academic standing
- d. Be worthy, deserving, and of good moral character
- e. Priority will be given to a junior or senior in college
- f. Attach an official high school transcript or college transcript (if applicable)
- g. Include two letters of recommendation from a teacher, community member or employer.

Renewal Criteria:

Scholarship is renewable each year the student meets all set criteria listed above.

Selection Process:

The recipient of the Robert & Regina D. Roth Scholarship shall be recommended to the Mott/Regent School Board for approval.

The scholarship application deadline will be no later than July 15, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. (MT). The award will be announced by July 31, 2020.
