The recipient of the Robert & Regina D. Roth Scholarship shall be recommended to the Mott Regent School Board for approval.

The scholarship application deadline will be no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. (MT). The award will be announced by July 13, 2018.
